## **ENROLLMENT VERIFICATION**

An enrollment verification is a document indicating student enrollment status and includes: enrolled status of full or part-time, credit hours, and expected date of graduation.

The University of New Hampshire has authorized the **National Student Clearinghouse** to act as its agent for verification of enrollment status. Enrollment data is sent to the National Student Clearinghouse soon after the standard add/drop period. Once the data has been processed by the Clearinghouse, students may obtain an enrollment verification pdf certificate by logging on to <u>Webcat</u> and linking to the National Student Clearinghouse website. Students may print a certification of enrollment to send to their health insurers and credit issuers. Students can view any electronic notification forms that the Clearinghouse has sent to their lenders, servicers, and guarantors.
