The program also includes courses in dance history, choreography, composition and pedagogy, as well as innovative offerings like Dance Technology (Compocinema) and Famous Dancers of the 21st Century.

Professional development opportunities include internships, guest artist workshops, and studyabroad experiences like The London Experience, which explores the intersections of theatre, dance, and culture.
